

NSLHA Procedure for Maintaining Non-Profit Status Revised: 2009

Corporation in Nebraska must file a biennial report with the Corporation Division of the Secretary of State's office. That office sends a notice to our agent every other year on the odd years. Notice is sent in December and the stated fee must be paid by June. The Executive Administrator will present the notice to the Board for approval to pay the fees so that non-profit status is maintained.

Articles of Incorporation were filed with the Corporation Division May 13, 1971. All changes to the Articles of Incorporation must be submitted to the Corporation Division. By-laws may be amended at-will and amendments are not filed with the Corporation Division. The NSLHA Articles of Incorporation are available at the NSLHA Office.
