Research Information for Web Site

Researchers and students who wish to use the NSLHA internet resources for legitimate research projects are asked to submit basic information regarding their research project, its protocol, any benefit to subjects, funding sources, and approval from an institutional review board (IRB). An IRB is the oversight body charged with ensuring protection of human subjects in research. The information provided will be submitted to NSLHA's web site administrator for review and determination of approval for posting.

The sole purpose of posting subject recruitment notices is to inform members of NSLHA about ongoing research and to do so in a responsible manner. Any decision of NSLHA members to participate will be based on their contact with the researchers themselves; the posting of the information on the NSLHA web site does not constitute endorsement by NSLHA, or its Board of Directors.

Research requests will not be sent out via email. Members will visit the web site for information about research requests.

Other Requests to Email Membership

If the NSLHA Director receives an email weather form a NSLHA member or non-member, requesting that a message be forwarded to the membership, the Director will first attempt to determine if the request involves personal financial gain. If so, the message will NOT be forwarded. If the email isn't for personal financial profit, it will be forwarded to the current NSLHA President who will decide whether or not to forward.
